Occupational Medicine specialists

- preventive medical examinations (pre-employment and periodical check-ups) in workers (with occupational exposure to agents scientifically proven to cause allergy or irritation)
- patients transfered from GPs to occupational medicine specialists with skin disease that is non-occupational or that is suspected to be caused by workplace substances (medical expertise for verification of occupational disease)

Specialists in Pediatrics

Sub-specialization in Immuno-allergology





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- How many patch tests will be performed in your department per month on average?
- Do you use market available commercial patch test substances or special preparations for common allergens?
- Do you patch more than the European standard series (e g occupation specific trays)?
- Do you patch test patients' own products?
 - about 100 patch tests per month at the Institute of Occupational Health of R. Macedonia, WHO CC
 - both within preventive medical examinations in workers and in patients with non-occupational or occupational skin disease
 - market available commercial patch test substances
 - both European standard series and occupation specific trays
 - testing also patients' own products

- Honorarium of patch test with patients own products and dilution?

Preventive medical examinations in workers

- employer pays for patch testing and other specific examinations (about 20 Eur per patch test series - either for commercial substances or patients' own products)

Patients transfered from GPs to occupational medicine specialists (and other specialities) - patch testing partly covered by Health Insurance Fund (10-20% pays patient, and 80-90% covered by HIF)

- about 30 Eur per patch test series patient pays 3 Eur, and 27 Eur covered by HIF - either for commercial substances or patients' own products
- about 10 Eur per patch test with one allergen
- about 15 Eur per patch test with two or three allergens
